Reporting to the Health and Safety Manager in Calgary, the primary role of this key position is to support Field operations by providing H&S support to our Production, Drilling, Completion and Facility Construction operations as well as Corporate programs. This position is field based out of our Spirit River, Alberta office.

Key Responsibilities

- To support and provide guidance in regards to Birchcliff's Health and Safety programs.
- Participate in and train required field personnel on our Emergency Response Plan.
- Work with all Birchcliff Operations Teams, including Wellsite Leaders and Facilities Supervisors to ensure compliance with Birchcliff's expectations and H&S programs.
- Participate in and audit contractor safety programs/meetings.
- Support contractors conducting H&S field activities. This would include regular discussions with Birchcliff representatives as well as the contract services to review ongoing programs and provide direction.
- Participate in incident investigations as an initial response along with the Operations representatives. This includes ensuring all investigations are completed with root cause and effective corrective actions.
- Support and ensure continuous improvement of our Training and Competency program for Birchcliff Field Leaders and Supervisors.
- Participate in Simultaneous Operations projects.
- Participate in pre-job kickoff meetings as well as Health and Safety reviews post-job.
- Participate in pre-job and facility inspections, both safety and regulatory. This would include training and support for the Operations teams in the process.
- Support and participate in Synergy Groups.
- This role will include being on call for Emergency Response and Incident Investigations.
- Participate and represent with the Production Joint Health and Safety Committee.

Education, Skills and Abilities

- Must have 10 years' experience in the Oil & Gas industry with a majority of their career being health and safety focused.
- Must have H&S experience in Production Operations and/or Drilling & Completions.
- A valid OH&S Certificate or University Equivalent is a minimum requirement however, preference will be given to a Canadian Registered Safety Professional.
- Must have a background or training in Incident Investigation.
- Motivated to support all aspects of our Operations with continual enhancement of our H&S programs.
- Must be able to manage time and priorities.
- Advanced communication skills, including written, verbal and computer.
- Demonstrate a keen interest for accuracy and attention to detail.
- Strong organizational skills and excellent critical thinking skills.
- Must be a Great Team Player and add professional input into decisions.
- The ability to work as a team member and effectively support and work with Birchcliff Leaders.

- Regular travel required from our Spirit River Office to all of our operational areas with some travel to Calgary.
- The candidate is *required to currently live* within a maximum of one-hour radius of our Spirit River Field Office (i.e. Dawson Creek or Grande Prairie area). Do not apply if you do not currently meet this requirement.
