This position is field based out of our Spirit River, Alberta office.

Key Responsibilities

- Work with our very engaged Field Leadership and Corporate Health and Safety Teams.
- To support and provide guidance in regards to Birchcliff's Health and Safety systems.
- Participate in and train required personnel on our Emergency Response Plan.
- Work with Birchcliff Representatives to ensure that they are meeting Birchcliff's expectations and competencies.
- Participate in and support contractor safety programs/meetings, when possible.
- Support contractors conducting Health and Safety field activities. This would include regular discussions with Birchcliff representatives as well as the contract services to review ongoing programs and provide support and direction.
- Participate in HSE incident investigations as an initial response along with the Operations representatives.
- Participate in Simultaneous Operations projects.
- Participate in pre-job kickoff meetings as well as HSE reviews post-job.
- Participate in pre-job inspections and facility inspections, safety and/or regulatory. This would include mentoring Operations staff in the process.

Education, Skills and Abilities

- Must have 5 years' experience in the Oil & Gas industry with a majority of their career being health and safety focused.
- Preference for those with experience in Drilling, Completions and/or Production Operations.
- Preference will be given to a CRSP, with consideration for those currently holding an OH&S Certificate or University Equivalent.
- Motivated to support all aspects of our Operations.
- Must be able to manage time and priorities.
- Advanced communication skills, including written, verbal and computer.
- Must be comfortable to present in front of groups.
- Demonstrate a keen interest for accuracy and attention to detail.
- Strong organizational skills and excellent critical thinking skills.

- The ability to work as a team member and effectively mentor and work with staff.
- Regular travel required to all of our operational areas with some travel to Calgary.
